**[PROPOSED] ORDER GRANTING
JOINT MOTION TO DISMISS WITH PREJUDICE**

Before the Court is the Joint Motion to Dismiss with Prejudice filed by Plaintiff Fractus, S.A. (“Fractus”) and Defendants Verizon Connect Inc. and Celco Partnership (d/b/a Verizon Wireless) (together, “Verizon”). In the Joint Motion to Dismiss, Fractus and Verizon represent that they have settled all claims for relief in case 2:24-cv-1009. Fractus and Verizon request that case 2:24-cv-1009 be dismissed with prejudice.

Having considered the Motion, and noting its joint nature, the Court finds that the same should be and hereby is **GRANTED**. The Court **ACCEPTS AND ACKNOWLEDGES** that all claims and causes of action asserted by Fractus against Verizon in case 2:24-cv-1009 are **DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE**. All attorneys’ fees, expenses, and costs of court shall be

borne by each party incurring the same.
